90/10 Camera Participation Rule

Attendance Policy

- **Students are allowed a maximum number of 2 absences throughout the entire course. Once a student has reached 3 absences, they will be asked to retake the course.** If a student that has 3 or more absences decides to retake the course, it will be free of charge if they decide to take it for a consecutive semester (immediately after the original semester they had registered for).

- Please note that logging into class 15 minutes late or more is considered tardy, and that 3 tardies equal to 1 absence.

Statement of Faith

Christian-based Statement of Faith

It is assumed that all enrolled students have read the Chaplains College School of

THE HOLY SCRIPTURES

We believe God is Triune: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (2 Corinthians 13:14)

THE FALL OF MAN

We believe baptism by immersion is an outward sign of an inward work (Matthew 28:19). We believe in commemorating the Lord’s Supper by the symbolic use of the bread and juice of the vine. (1 Corinthians 11:24-25)
